PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS AND DENTAL INSURANCE

Effort is made to keep the cost of dental care under control. Fees charged are determined by time spent; vary with complexity and laboratory work involved. Before treatment begins, fees and procedures are explained.

Charges for professional dental services are due at the time of treatment unless prior written arrangements are made. Visa, MasterCard, Discover, Care Credit, cash, assignment of insurance benefit, and personal check are acceptable forms of payment.

This office accepts most dental insurance plans offered at your place of employment. The co-payment and deductible are patient's responsibility to pay at time of service. Understanding the specific details of any plan is the sole obligation of the patient.

A predetermination is a written estimation of coverage for planned dental work. This document can be submitted on your behalf to an insurance company prior to initiating treatment. We process predeterminations free of charge.

CENTRAL ILLINOIS DENTAL PLAN

This is a non-insurance access to care program for adults offered exclusively at this office. It is intended for people who do not have dental insurance or do not have a regular dentist and want to be treated with some confidence of cost control. Features include:

1. special fee structure and no interest payment plans with credit approval
2. coordination with existing dental insurance*
3. immediate access to care
4. no hidden fees, no restrictions
5. free initial consultation

*rules and regulations of any current insurance plan still apply

SEQUENCING TREATMENT

Dr. Nalepka is an advocate of The Concept of Complete Dentistry where:

1. Initially, gum disease, decay, infection, hopeless teeth, and cosmetic embarrassment are treated. Disease elimination is the objective. Requirements necessary to prevent future disease are established.
2. After health is regained, a plan for long term stability in structure and function is made. Influencing factors include:
 - patient's ideas
 - lingering symptoms
 - existing conditions like quality of current dental work, missing teeth, drifted teeth, mobile teeth, and prognosis of possible previous gum disease
 - consultation with specialists
 - health of the jaw joints
 - harmful habits like smoking or teeth grinding or clenching
 - cosmetic goals
 - nutrition
 - oral hygiene routine
 - systemic health
 - investment allowance
 - scheduling requirements
3. Final restorative work is completed. This might include any combination of fillings, crowns, bridges, partial dentures, complete dentures, implants and veneers.

ABOUT THE PRACTICE

This is a practice of general dentistry. Focus is on providing you with advice and treatment like we would want for our own family. Our wish is to have our patients understand that dental health requires a lifelong commitment to regular dental checkups and routine home care.

ABOUT THE DENTIST

Dr. Nalepka and his family live in Washington, IL. He was born in Chicago and got his undergraduate and dental degree from the University of Illinois. The move south to the heart of Illinois occurred in 1987 and the purchase of the dental practice at 233 Meadow happened in 1992. Memberships include the American Dental Association, Peoria Dental Society, The Academy of General Dentistry, The Academy of Laser Dentistry, and the Rotary Club of East Peoria. Academic programs include the University of Minnesota continuum for esthetic dentistry multi-year program, the Misch Institute for implant surgical and prosthetic training, The United States Dental Institute for orthodontics, and continuum six at the L. D. Pankey Institute in Key Biscayne for restorative dentistry.

ON YOUR FIRST VISIT

A medical and dental history and registration form is completed. If you request a cleaning, you will be seen by the hygienist; otherwise the dentist will see you. Necessary x-rays are taken. If you have an emergency or a major concern, that will be addressed first. The results of the examination will be discussed and dialogue is encouraged. Options for treatment are reviewed. If a plan of treatment is reached, then it is put in writing for your review and authorization. Of course fees and insurance coverage is estimated.
